places were closed. CDR picked them up and at eight weeks old, all the pups were adopted out, including their mom, to some excellent homes. CDR works with several vets and local police departments to help in situations like this.

### *Allie & Her Babies*

Animal control officers were called out to a rural house on a complaint that a dog was tied to a tree. It was a very cold February day when they came upon Allie, a one year old lab mix, who had no shelter, food or water. As if that wasn't bad enough, the officer found five 1-week old puppies laying next to her! They picked up the family, however, they were taken to a high kill shelter. The



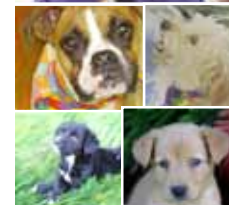
shelter staff frantically started to look to place this family somewhere to give them a chance at life. CDR gladly took the call, despite how sick this family was. Allie was about half the size she should have been, the pups were all frostbitten, and one pup even had an eye infection. While two of the pups died several weeks later, the rest of family have all found their forever homes. The two that died at least died knowing what love was and did not die alone in the cold. Both were in their loving foster mom's arms.

## Great Dane Donation: \$1,000 & Up

This will be done a minimum ten (10) times throughout the year.

- We will provide you with a plaque and updates on the dogs you have helped save.
- Your business information will go out by email to volunteers and people who inquire about dogs.

If you provide business cards or coupons, we would even be willing to hand these out at some of the events, whenever possible (not all events will allow us to do this). This will be done a minimum one (1) time during the year.
- Your logo will be included on a banner we use at many of the events throughout the year CDR attends.
- We will provide you with a window cling saying you are a proud sponsor of our rescue.
- Your business information will go out by email to volunteers and people who inquire about dogs.



## Tea Cup Yorkie Donation: \$25 - \$99

- Your business will be the sponsor for one of the dogs we have during 2012 and will be listed on the dogs bio page until he/she has been adopted.

## Dog Training Program: Minimum \$500

- Any of our dogs in training will wear a vest with your business listed on it. If the dog is at an adoption event, he/she will also wear the vest. 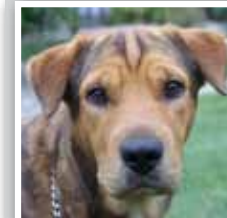
### Donation Jars

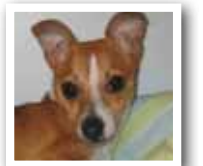
**Duke**

Duke is one of our rescues who is heartworm positive. Treatment for heartworm is very expensive and also very hard on the dog.
